Request for Applications for Regional Coaches

Chemonics International Inc. the prime contractor for the United States Agency for International Development (USAID)-funded [Monitoring and Evaluation Services for the Civil Society Fund](#) (CSF MEA), USAID contract number 617-C-00-09-00001-00, and the USAID-funded [Technical Management Agent for the Civil Society Fund Program](#) (CSF TMA), USAID contract number 617-C-10-00005, seeks suitable candidates to provide capacity building to civil society organizations (CSOs) in a decentralized capacity building approach using a Regional Technical Assistance (RTA) Teams Model. The RTA model aims at building capacity of CSOs using locally based experts (regional coaches).

The Civil Society Fund (CSF) was established under the Uganda AIDS Commission to support the objectives of the National Strategic Plan for HIV/AIDS and Orphans and Other Vulnerable Children (OVC). The goal of the CSF is to ensure that civil society provision of prevention, care, treatment, and support services in HIV/AIDS and OVC are harmonized, streamlined, effective, and in support of the GOU National Strategic Plan, National Priority Action Plan, and other national plans and policies. Chemonics' CSF TMA and CSF MEA projects are tasked to support the effective functioning of the CSF through the management and oversight of the technical assistance and monitoring and evaluation components. In partnership with the Financial Management Agent (FMA), the CSF TMA and MEA specifically provide support to the CSF in its function of providing technical and M&E support and supervision to grantees to scale up effective and comprehensive responses to HIV/AIDS, and OVC in Uganda.

Applications are invited from suitable candidates to build capacity of CSF supported CSOs for the period ending June 2012 in any of the following areas:

1. Monitoring and Evaluation,
2. HIV/AIDS prevention,
3. HIV/AIDS Care and support,
4. OVC protection, care and support,
5. Gender programming,
6. Management and Organizational development.

Technical expertise in two or more areas is an added advantage. This is not a full time assignment requiring a fixed salary. The stipulated honorarium will be paid based on level of effort during the delivery of stipulated outputs.
